The Code is intended to promote and maintain the highest standard of ethical behaviour by P&C Association members. Members of a P&C Association should adhere to the Code of Conduct at all times. This Code applies to each member of a P&C Association.

P&C Association members are to:

- act in the best interest of the whole school community at all times
- act in compliance with the Constitution
- act and work within the boundaries of the *Education (General Provisions) Act 2006*, the *Education (General Provisions) Regulation 2017* and the Department of Education's policies and procedures relevant to P&C Association operations
- conduct and present themselves in a professional manner and act ethically and with integrity at all times
- act with courtesy and demonstrate respect for all persons, whether fellow P&C Association members, school staff, parents/carers, students, community members
- remain objective and avoid personal bias at all times
- represent all members of the school community
- engage the school and wider community in developing and effecting school priorities, policies and decisions in a manner that is consultative, respectful and fair
- declare any conflicts of interest and not misuse their office to advance individual views or for personal gain
- make fair, transparent and consistent decisions
- provide objective and independent advice
- listen and be tolerant of the views and opinions of others, even if those views and opinions differ from their own
- treat official information with care and use it only for the purpose for which it was collected or authorised
- respect confidentiality and information privacy (about the school, community members, staff or students) at all times and not disclose confidential information
- not use confidential or privileged information to further personal interests
- be responsive to the requirements of the school community
- seek to achieve excellence in educational outcomes for all students at the school
- listen and respond to issues and concerns regarding strategy and policy.

Blue Card Information

(required for non-parent/carer members and all Executive Committee Members)

To join the P&C as a community member at the school, you will need to apply for a blue card. This includes relatives of a student who are not the parent or carer, such as grandparents. Additionally, any members of the P&C executive also required a blue card, even where they are the parent of a child at the school.

If you have previously supplied your Blue Card information to the P&C for linking in our register, then it will be automatically updated for as long as you are linked. You will not need to provide your details again - please tick the appropriate box below and you can skip the rest of this page.

There is no fee for cards for volunteers, but if you do not already have one, you will need to register with the Blue Card system and supply your registration number and DOB so you can be linked with our Blue Card register. You can scan the QR code to go to the appropriate website, or search for "Apply for Blue Card" in a browser. Once this is done, we will email to confirm the link with our register and you will be able to apply for a Blue Card with no fee.



Also note that your identification photo needs to be less than 7 years old to be able to proceed. If you are not able to register at present and need your photo updated, please check the box below to indicate you will provide your Blue Card information separately as soon as possible (you can email to pandc@corindass.eq.edu.au).

Note that since September 20, 2025, Blue Cards are also required for some parent volunteers:

- any member of the Executive Committee of the P&C
- parents volunteering with children not including their own child (eg. helping with a Year 5 pottery class when your own child is in Year 3)
- where the parent may require close personal contact with a child other than their own (such as changing clothes or bathing)
- parents who are attending an overnight camp/excursion

Please choose one of the following options.

- I am a parent/carer volunteer who will not require a Blue Card (by checking this box, you are confirming you have noted the exceptions above and that they will not apply to you).
- I have already provided my Blue Card information and am linked in the P&C Blue Card register.
