

BYOx Decision Process

2017 - 2018

Australian Curriculum demands an increase in digital technology

- Assessment of school-based devices to meet Australian Curriculum requirements
- Team of teachers visit 1-to-1 device school
- STEM teacher appointed to work with every student and teacher
- STEM Lab created - touchscreen computers, 3D printers, robotics and mobile devices

2018 - 2nd Semester

Years 4 - 6 require more access to devices to meet curriculum

- Discussion about 1-to-1 devices (BYOx) at Corinda begins with staff and P&C forum
- Principal and P&C share information to the community about establishing a BYOx Steering Committee

2019 - Term 1

School commits to exploring Bring Your Own Device (BYOx)

- Steering Committee forms - four Teachers, four Parent representatives, one Principal
- Steering Committee decision to engage in a “listening period” with the community
- Email to families introducing BYOx and ongoing newsletter article updates
- Pop up Booth at Parent-Teacher Information Night
- Steering Committee Meetings - feedback from Pop up Booth and discussion of proposed model
- Discussion at March P&C Meeting
- Email to families inviting further BYOx feedback via email or school office
- Teaching Staff update at staff meeting
- Steering Committee engage in ongoing internal communication about BYOx feedback, BYOx proposed model and information sharing process

2019 Term 2

Where to next?

- Making an informed decision. Proposed BYOx model shared with families and staff in week one of Term 2
- Two community BYOx Information Sessions available in Term 2 (as an option for families to discuss the proposed BYOx model). Thursday 23 May (7pm to 9pm) and Saturday 25 May (9am to 11am)
- Teaching staff information session early Term 2
- Corinda State School community vote on introduction of the proposed BYOx model
(Simple Yes / No vote process – on-line or paper options for parents and staff)
- Steering Committee scrutinise votes
- Steering Committee provides feedback on the BYOx decision to community

Community vote

YES result

Semester 2 - 2019

- *Expression of Interest* to teach Year 4 2020 submitted by teachers
- Further IT and support information sessions for Year 4 families (to be an annual/ ongoing undertaking)
- Teachers of Year 4 2020 supplied with iPad and professional development
- School IT team establish *BYO iPad* policies and set up for smooth transition in 2020
- 3rd Party purchase / finance option established

2020 and moving on...

- All classes continue to receive STEM lessons for two terms per year
- All classes have option to access computer lab once per week
- School supplements classes with school-based devices
- Roll-out *BYO iPad* option for Year 4-6s

Community vote

NO result

Ongoing

- School continues to support digital curriculum and ICT skills with only school-based devices
- Classes continue to receive STEM lessons for two terms per year
- Classes continue to access computer lab once per week

2019 Term 3

YES vote for Year 4 BYO iPad 2020

- 326 online and paper votes registered by parents and staff in the Corinda Community.
- Threshold of 255 votes met, therefore determining the result a valid representation.

Results were as follows:

- Yes 182 votes 55.82%
- No 91 votes 27.91%
- Neutral 53 votes 16.26%

These votes provide the school with a mandate to introduce a Year 4 BYO iPad option for families starting in 2020.
