

Enhancement Day

Corinda State School offers two days per year where children are encouraged to try some new activities that are not part of the normal school Teaching and Learning. They are designed to address the General capabilities strands of the Australian Curriculum – especially the **Critical and Creative thinking** strand.

Typically, these days are held in week 10 of Second and Fourth term. They have a nil cost to parents and are school funded and teacher supervised. Most of the activities are held on school grounds, and students wear normal school uniform, unless otherwise instructed.

For Lower school students (**Prep to year 2**) we call these days **Under 8's** or **Summer 8's**.

For **Year 3 to Year 6** we use the term **Enhancement day**.

Teachers at the school offer a range of interesting activities for children to sample. At various times we also have outside providers who offer their expertise with different activities.

Examples of activities we have offered in the past include:

Herbology; Articulated Hands; Musical Theatre; Strings Masterclass; Inventors Academy; Still Life Drawing; Chess; Futsal; Building Challenge; Master Chef; a Capella ...
